

Starter package for external EPR communications

For healthcare institutions





This starter package for external EPR communications informs your (potential) patients as well as their relatives and visitors about the electronic patient record (EPR).

As soon as your healthcare institution is connected to the EPR, these groups should also be informed and have some knowledge of the EPR.



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Introduction

In the summer of 2023, the Federal Office of Public Health (FOPH), eHealth Suisse and the cantons launched the "EPR is effective" campaign to raise awareness about the EPR among health professionals. The campaign will then be rolled out for the general public. The exact date is not yet known.

Sanela coordinates its communications with those of eHealth Suisse, the federal government and the cantons. To ensure consistent and coherent communications, we refer and link whenever possible to the official EPR information platform (patientendossier.ch) of eHealth Suisse, the federal government and the cantons. The platform has comprehensive information about the EPR for the general public and health professionals, and you can order EPR information materials such as flyers, brochures and posters there as well.

Your healthcare institution is connected to the EPR and you are therefore a part of it. This means you too can use your external EPR communications to actively build awareness of the EPR. Being linked to the EPR requires internal resources and incurs costs, also in the future. However, the benefits of these investments increase with the number of patients who use an EPR. The more patients have an EPR, the more you stand to benefit from its advantages. Managing your external communications about the EPR can help you promote and support this development actively.

The following Sanela starter package is designed to help you set up and manage your external communications about the EPR.

External communications have the following goals:

- Make the public more aware of the EPR in general
- Inform the public about the importance of the EPR in general
- Get more people in Switzerland to use the EPR

Examples of external communication can include:

- Flyers (and posters) in the healthcare institution to advertise the EPR
- Screen ads with a QR code for setting up the EPR
 (link to Sanela website for doing so online) and a clear call to action
- Flyer in the admission package
 All patients receive a flyer with information about setting up an EPR when they join the healthcare institution
- QR code for setting up an EPR printed on the admission documents;
 send the EPR flyer electronically as part of some admissions
- Include information about the EPR on your website

Use of "Post Sanela Health Ltd," "Sanela reference community" and "Sanela"

Post Sanela Health Ltd offers the EPR as part of the Sanela reference community in accordance with the Federal Act on the Electronic Patient Record (EPRA) to the general public, healthcare institutions and their healthcare professionals. Sanela is working with Swiss Post to develop the necessary technical infrastructure.

Clarification of the terms "Sanela reference community," "Post Sanela Health Ltd" and "Sanela"

Sanela reference community

This is not an official organisation (entity), but is based on a joint contractual framework. It includes all members (healthcare institutions and their health professionals) who have delegated their statutory obligations to Post Sanela Health Ltd. The term Sanela reference community is used in communications only when referring specifically to the reference community.

Post Sanela Health Ltd

This is the operator of the Sanela reference community.

Post Sanela Health Ltd therefore offers its members a certified reference community.

Use of the Sanela key visual and the Post logo

You are permitted to Sanela's key visual (the iris of a human eye) and the slogan "Focus on health" in your communications, but please observe the respective guidelines.

4.1 Use of the Sanela key visual

Sanela's key visual is the main design element and is used in various advertising media, such as flyers, posters, roll-ups, websites and the EPR Postbus. It aims to communicate the brand consistently and to make it clearly identifiable and easily recognisable.

It is permitted to use the Sanela key visual for EPR communications. When using the Sanela key visual, the eye must always be shown in full and no letters may cover it.

The key visual can be downloaded from the Sanela website: Communication materials The "Sanela – focus on health" slogan promotes recognition and identification in communications. The slogan for EPR communications can be used but must always include the prescribed text 1:1.

6.1 EPR

6.1.1 Brief explanation of the EPR

Headline

Option 1 With the EPR, you can access your health data anywhere at any time

Option 2 With the EPR, all treatment-relevant documents are in one place.

Short example

The electronic patient record (EPR) is a digital collection of important information about your health. The EPR lets you view and store your medical data online. This means you and the health professionals you authorise can access important health information at any time.

Long example

The electronic patient record (EPR) is a digital collection of important information about your health. This includes, for example, hospital and care reports on examination results, medication lists and the digital vaccination record. You can share this information easily and securely with the designated healthcare professionals. Thanks to the EPR, your medical data is always available and retrievable via a secure internet connection. This means you and the healthcare professionals you authorise can access important health information about you at any time.

6.1.2 Why do I need an EPR?

Short example

With the EPR, your health data is:

- Safe in one place
- Available at all times
- Immediately available in an emergency

You have full control over your health data

Long example

The EPR lets you manage your health data yourself

- Control over your EPR: You decide who can access your health data
- Access to your health data: You and the authorised healthcare professionals can access your EPR at any time
- Immediately available in an emergency: In an emergency, vital information is immediately available
- Safe in one place: Your EPR is available at all times via a secure internet connection, and your health data is stored securely in Switzerland in compliance with data protection regulations
- Better treatment quality and more patient safety are the main goals of the EPR. Improve the quality of your healthcare by setting up your EPR
- Appointment of EPR deputies: Share or delegate how your EPR is used

6.1.4 How secure is the EPR?

Example

Data protection and privacy are vitally important for the EPR. The EPR is subject to the Federal Act on the Electronic Patient Record (EPRA) and the Federal Act on Data Protection (FADP), which have strict rules on data protection and security. Sanela's EPR meets all these requirements. All data is stored in Switzerland. You will find more information about measures to protect your health data at patientendossier.ch.

6.2 Healthcare institutions offer the EPR

Long example

Set up your EPR now – completely digitally in three steps:

- 1. Create your verified electronic identity (eID) with SwissID if you do not already have one.
- 2. You apply for your EPR from Post Sanela Health Ltd.
- 3. You will receive a one-time, initial login for your EPR done!

It will take about 20-30 minutes to set up the EPR digitally. It will take a bit longer if you first have to open or complete a SwissID account.

Have the following ready when you set up your EPR digitally:

- Your biometric passport or identity card
 (Switzerland or EU/EEA; exception: German ID card)
- Your smartphone
- Access to your personal, active email account
- Login for your SwissID account and the SwissID app installed on your smartphone (latest version)

If you are under the age of 18 or have a custodian, the legal representative must set up the EPR. Please visit <u>post-sanela.ch</u> to learn how to set up your EPR.

Recommendation:

- Use your computer or tablet to set up the EPR:
 Start setting up the EPR on your computer or tablet and use your smartphone for the steps in the SwissID app. You can also complete all the steps on your smartphone.
- Use of passport for identification:
 Use your passport to verify your electronic identity. Your ID card is checked manually if you use it to authenticate yourself. You will be notified by email as soon as you can continue with the online set-up.
